The Legacy Student Leadership Team is for those HS students who have a passion and desire to see God use them to shape and grow our student ministry into all God wants it to be. Student leaders' job is to serve, serve, serve, and repeat.

What does it take to be on a Student Leadership Team?

- * You must be in 9th-12th grade.
- * You must be an active part of Legacy Student Ministry. Attending either High School, Sunday School, or Bible Study events.
- * Attend monthly training meetings. (time and location TBD)
- * Fill out an application and submit to Vicky.
- * Meet with Vicky or Sam for interview and training before beginning to serve.

What are the responsibilities of being a leader?

1. Be a reflection of Christ to those around you. Look for ways to serve and help. Keep the purposes of our ministry in mind: to help students **discover** Jesus, **connect** with each other, and **impact** their world.
2. Jump in to any activities, being present and engaged during ministry events. Be inclusive and welcoming. Student Leaders help create an atmosphere of acceptance and friendship for all.
3. Every Student Leader will be on a specific subteam with a particular role in the ministry. You will be responsible for doing your part on that team. See the teams on the back of this page.
4. Commit to serving for the entire school year from September - May. Let Vicky or Sam know in advance if you can't do your assigned jobs any given week.

Can a student ever be asked to step down from Leadership?

It's rare, but yes. If you are no longer able or willing to attend ministry events or your presence in our group becomes unhelpful or divisive, you will be asked (privately) to step down from the team.

Below are the teams that make up the Student Leadership Team.

All leaders, from any team, will be a part of our monthly training and planning meetings. A portion of that meeting will be dedicated to ‘team time’ where you can plan and prepare things specific to your team duties.

SMALL GROUP LEADERS:

(Required to be 3 school grades older than group you’re serving)

Leaders will be paired with adults to help lead a Middle School Small Group on Wednesdays. Leaders will engage in conversation about the night’s lesson. Affirm and encourage the students in their group. Help keep order and assist the adult leader in any ways needed. These leaders are examples to younger students of how to carry faith into your high school years. They are encouraged to share their own stories honestly while keeping in mind what is appropriate for the age of their few MS students.

WORSHIP TEAM LEADERS:

While many students will make up the worship team, a few will take on this role of Student Leader within the team. They will work closely with Becca in deciding what music to do. They may be asked to pray, read Scripture, or share a story during worship time. They will help in the ministry organization, with duties such as communication, preparing music binders, set up and stage clean up.

TECH TEAM LEADERS:

The Teach Team leaders will be responsible for running the audio and video aspects of Wednesday night Middle School & High School. They will recruit and train a team of other students, and manage a schedule of who is running the show each week. They will encourage and affirm the students on their team, while helping them learn new skills and gain proficiency. They will work together with the worship team.

HOSPITALITY TEAM LEADERS:

These leaders will oversee a team that’s responsible for greeting, sign-in and welcoming new guests during Wed night Middle School & High School. They will recruit and train a team of students to be in charge of hospitality, and manage the schedule for who is serving each week. They will help visitors fill out information cards, provide them with an info packet, and enter them into the registration system.
