A. Gift of Administration

The special ability that God gives to clearly understand the immediate and long range goals of a ministry and devise, manage and execute plans to achieve goals and purposes for the church body.

B. Gift of Apostleship

The special ability that God gives to extend Christianity as a whole, primarily through direct mission and church planting; an apostle hears from the Holy Spirit and set things in order accordingly for the church's health, growth, maturity and outreach. These "pioneers" may also be able to work with other cultures.

C. Gift of Craftsmanship

The special ability that God gives to make use of available resources to meet the needs related to God's work and help accomplish the desired goals through creative work.

Ex. 31:1-11, Acts 9:39, Acts 18:3

D. Gift of Creative Communication

The special ability that God gives to express the truths, creativity and the love of God through art, drama, music, photography, etc. to further the message of the gospel.

E. Discernment

The special ability that God gives to know with assurance whether certain behaviors purported to be of God are in reality divine, human or evil. Able to see through chaos or confusion and determine problems and possible outcomes. Can correlate problems to violation of biblical truths.

F. Gift of Encouragement/Exhortation

Sometimes called the gift of counseling- the special ability that God gives to minister words of comfort, consolation, encouragement and counsel to other believers in such a way that they feel helped and are moving toward healing.

G. Evangelism

The special ability that God gives to share the gospel with non-believers (through genuine relationship) in such a way that they become followers of Christ and responsible members of the church. These “recruiters” are naturally infectious people who enlist others into the movement by transmitting the gospel.

H. Faith

The special ability to see with extraordinary confidence the will and purposes of God for future of His work even when others see only obstacles.

I. Giving

The special ability that God gives to contribute financially to the work of the Lord liberally and cheerfully, above and beyond the tithes and offerings expected to all believers.

J. Helps/Service

The special ability to invest time, talents and energy unselfishly in performing tasks for God’s work, often to assist other gifted individuals by freeing them to dedicate all their time to their primary ministry.

K. Hospitality

The special ability that God gives to reach out in warmth and love to make people welcome and care for their needs, particularly food, lodging and connection.

The special ability that God gives to pray for extended periods of time on a regular basis and see frequent and specific answers to prayer to a degree much greater than that of other followers of Christ.

M. Word of Knowledge

The special ability God gives to discover, accumulate, analyze and clarify information and ideas that are from the Holy Spirit that are pertinent to the growth and well-being of followers of Christ.

N. Leadership

The special ability that God gives to set goals in accordance with God's purpose for the future and to communicate these goals to others in such a way that motivates them to harmoniously work together to accomplish these goals for the glory of God.

O. Mercy

The special ability that God gives to feel genuine empathy and compassion for individuals, both followers of Christ and non-followers, who suffer distressing physical, mental or emotional problems, and to translate that compassion into cheerfully doing deeds that reflect Christ's love and alleviate suffering.

P. Prophecy

The special ability that God gives to receive and communicate an immediate message of God to His people. These "guardians" are called to maintain faithfulness to God among the people of God.

Q. Pastoral

The special ability that God gives to assume a long-term responsibility for the spiritual welfare of a group of God's people. As "shepherds," they are called to nurture spiritual development, maintain communal health, and encourage loving community among the people of God.
