- 874 total people worshiped on Wednesdays this summer

- 176 Legacy Kids volunteer team t-shirts have been handed out since May.
- More than 100 people went through the 13 stations at the Family Easter Experience
- 24 kids packed 1000 bags of food for the Backpacks for Kids program at Community Action
- **19 different soups** to taste at this year's Legacy Soup Challenge, raising almost \$500 for the BEFP
- 31 "birthdays in a bag" were packed for the Bismarck Emergency Food Pantry to give to kids in need
- 21 robots were entered in the Robot Building contest to raise money for our VBS mission project

- Legacy Students raised \$4,398 for the 30 Hour Famine, feeding 9 children for the year
- Students **served 199 meals** at the **Bismarck Banquet**
- We see, on average, **56 different** students each week
- Started a **new student leadership** team with 4 High School leaders
- **Confirmed 13 students** in grades 8th-11th; 92% are still active
- 14 students and kids went to UM summer camp
- **21 students** served in Watford City on a mini-mission trip





Our 9th annual Half-a-Christmas Challenge offering raised **\$41,064**, clearing the

goal of **\$40,000**. We've given away almost **\$350,000** through this one offering alone to projects outside the walls of Legacy.



The 3 year Impact Campaign concluded that sought to pay off our mortgage debt. At the end of 2017, only **\$400,000** remained on our nearly **\$6 million** 4 year old facility.


