Day 1: 1 John 4:20, James 3:17, Colossians 3:11

Frederick Douglass loved the "pure, peaceable, and impartial Christianity of Christ" and challenged churchgoers to live without hypocrisy. Hypocrisy is not failing to live up to Christ's moral standard, but rather saying one thing while doing something different. What ways do Christians today acknowledge Christ with their words yet deny him with their lifestyle?

Day 2: Ephesians 2:11-12, 1 Peter 3:15-16
