START TALKING | ASK A QUESTION TO GET YOUR GROUP TALKING.

- If you had to pick one sport to play for the rest of time, which of these would it be: golf, soccer or hockey? Why?
- Does the thought of the world ending ever come up in your thoughts? Why?

START THINKING | ASK A QUESTION TO GET YOUR GROUP THINKING.

- Jesus spent some time teaching about the end of time. The disciples even looked forward to it
- Read Matthew 24:6-8
- Does Jesus say the world will end? When does it say it will take place?
- Does it bring more comfort or anxiety knowing the world will come to an end but not soon?
- We generally have a negative, destructive view of the end. Read Rev. 21:1-4
- What will the actual end of time look like?

START SHARING | CHOOSE A QUESTION TO CREATE OPENNESS.

- Read Matthew 24:36-39
- When will Jesus come back? Why do people keep trying to predict the time anyway?
- Yes the world will end but we should not panic. We should be active.
- Read Matthew 24:40-44
- We should be active growing closer to and sharing the love of Jesus.
- Read Matthew 25:31-46
- Who will move into the Kingdom? Who will not?
- What active step can you take in growing closer to or sharing the love of Jesus?

START PRAYING | BE BOLD AND PRAY WITH POWER.

- *Lord Jesus, may we find comfort in the fact you will return again, to make everything right, to bring justice where there has not been any, to wipe away tears for every eye for all time. If you return in my lifetime, may I be found to be doing your work when you return, bring hope, healing and wholeness in your name. Amen.*
