- What does it look like to live at peace with everyone around us? How should we live?
- Sometimes space and margin is required for healthy relationships.
- What does it look like to make space for your primary relationships in your life?
- What steps can you take this week to make room and margin for those most important to you?

START PRAYING | BE BOLD AND PRAY WITH POWER.

Lord Jesus, we can become so consumed with our stuff and with our accomplishments we forget that live is about people. Help us to prioritize the most important people in our lives, the ones you have given us to care about, and do whatever we can to make room for them.
