- What words or phrases stand out to you?
- In Paul's closing words to Timothy, what specific advice does he give with our wealth?
- What happens if we follow Paul's advice?

START SHARING | CHOOSE A QUESTION TO CREATE OPENNESS.

- What does it look like to put our trust in God and not in money?
- What are some specific examples to do good with our resources?
- What are some ways, this week, we can share what God has given us to steward with others?

START PRAYING | BE BOLD AND PRAY WITH POWER.

Lord Jesus, we desire a right relationship with you so that we have a right relationship with money. Challenge us where we need to grow. Encourage us where we are doing good works and sharing what you've given us. Inspire us to act, to move, to give when we see a need this week. In your resurrected name we pray together, Amen.
