START TALKING | ASK A QUESTION TO GET YOUR GROUP THINKING.

START THINKING | ASK A QUESTION TO GET YOUR GROUP THINKING.

- Read Numbers 20:1-13. What words or phrases stand out to you?
- Why are the people complaining?
- What does Moses do?
- How does God respond in verses 12-13?

START SHARING | CHOOSE A QUESTION TO CREATE OPENNESS.

- Hitting the rock instead of speaking to it causes Moses to not enter the promised land. Is that a fair consequence?
- In anger at the people, Moses relies on his own abilities, seen before to bring water out of a rock, instead of relying on God. Have you ever relied on your own abilities and not God's to see you through?

START PRAYING | BE BOLD AND PRAY WITH POWER.

- Lord Jesus, we confess we are an independent people and do not want to rely on anyone, including you. May your Holy Spirit help us to see our actions have consequences and you want to help us live your abundant life here and now. Help us to move when you say move and to stop when you say stop. In your resurrected name we pray, Amen.
