- Read Luke 2:16-20. What words or phrases stand out to you?
- After meeting Mary, Joseph and Jesus, what does verse 17 say they do?
- In our day, we need to listen and love others before we can share our story. What are specific ways we can listen to others? What are specific ways we can love?
- If you are comfortable, share your story of how you came to make Jesus the Lord of your life. Write down the highlights in your journal or notepad on your phone.

## START PRAYING | BE BOLD AND PRAY WITH POWER.

- Jesus, we are challenged by the shepherds, the students, the descendants, and the slaves of long ago who sang of the hope found in you, in situations that must have felt entirely hopeless. As we enter a new year, may we listen, truly, to others; may we love one another and everyone, without expecting anything in return; and may we take opportunities, through the Holy Spirit, to share our story as times naturally arise.
