- Read Luke 10:25-29. What words or phrases jump out to you?
- How does Jesus answer the man's question?
- What do you think the man wants Jesus' answer to be in the question in verse 29?

START SHARING | CHOOSE A QUESTION TO CREATE OPENNESS.

- Read Luke 10:30-35. What words or phrases jump out to you?
- What three people are mentioned in the story? How do they respond to the man on the road?
- Who do you expect to act compassionately? Who actually does?
- Read Luke 10:36-37. What words or phrases jump out to you?
- Jews and Samaritans had generations of hostility and racial conflict. How does that change who Jesus makes the hero of this story? What tone do you hear the man's reply in verse 37?
- What is one way you can love regardless in your life this week?

START PRAYING | BE BOLD AND PRAY WITH POWER.

Lord Jesus, we confess it is much easier to love those we agree with, to love those who seem like us. But you have called us to the tough work of loving everyone, even our enemies. May your Holy Spirit empower us to truly love others, a love that costs something, that requires something of us, just as sending you to earth required something of God.
